BOOK CLUB

Consider joining a book club this winter. We have three books available to choose from. Sign up sheets are available in the foyer.

You can obtain the book yourself or we can order it for you. You will be given time to read the book, then meet together for a pot-luck to discuss what you have learned

1. **The Road Back To You** - "What you don't know about yourself can hurt you and your relationships, and how you make your way in the world. It can also keep you in the shallows with God. Do you want help figuring out who you are and why you repeatedly stumble into the same self-defeating patterns? Consider the ancient personality types system called the Enneagram."

2. **The Storm-Tossed Family** - "This book teaches readers whether you are married or single, whether you long for a child or shepherding a full house, you are part of a family. Family is difficult because family - every family - is an echo of the gospel. Family can be the source of some of the most transcendent human joy, and family can leave us crumpled up on the side of the road. Family can make us who we are, and family can break our hearts. Why would this social arrangement have that much power, for good or for ill, over us? The only safe harbor for a storm-tossed family is a nail-scarred home."

3. **Divine Direction** - "We all want to make the right choices today that lead to a better tomorrow. But too many Christ followers are living with regret, making poor decisions because of guilt, feeling helpless over the direction of their lives, or simply because they are too distracted. Divine Direction will help you seek wisdom through seven principles so that you can start making godly decisions today with your future story in mind."
